Virtual Security Risk Management Workshop

11 Mon -15 Fri September 2023

The UNHCR Regional Centre for Emergency Preparedness | eCentre and Japan NGO Initiative for Safety and Security | JaNISS are pleased to call for applications to the virtual Security Risk Management Workshop (SRM) planned from 11 to 15 September 2023.

What is this workshop about?

Development and humanitarian actors are increasingly called upon to work and manage projects in high-risk security environments, including during the response and recovery phases of humanitarian emergencies. Awareness of the threats and risks — and how to respond appropriately to security incidents — can be a matter of life or death. It's equally important that managers and staff are able to anticipate, analyse, take steps to reduce security risks and ensure operation continuity.

The SRM will address the basics of security risk management, providing managers with practical tools to analyse and address security risks in the field. Current cases from high-risk environments will be discussed, along with best practices and lessons learned. The workshop will be highly interactive, involving short presentations, discussion and group work designed to apply and reflect upon the development of core skills.

Who is this workshop for?

This SRM online workshop is designed for humanitarian and development professionals at mid or senior levels, who manage operations, projects, personnel and assets in complex security environments.

What are the main themes of the workshop?

- The current security environment for aid workers
- Latest developments in the UN Security Management System
- Identification, assessment of security threats, analysis of security risks and identification and implementation of appropriate measures to mitigate risks
- Assessment of programme criticality
- Security planning
- Critical Incident Management Virtual Exercise (Remote Exercise Management)
- Centrality of Protection
- Duty of care

What you will gain from attending the workshop?

- A better understanding of contemporary risk management practices and how to apply these in your duty station and ensure continuity of the operation
- Knowledge of tools to better assess security risk, take steps to mitigate it, and respond to security incidents when they do occur
- Greater confidence in your ability to manage risk and respond to security issues in diverse situations

Selection criteria

- Language: This event will be conducted in the English language; applicants must be highly proficient in written and spoken English language.
- Experience: Applicants must have minimum of one year of working experience in the related field.
- Participation: Applicants must be able to participate in all five days (11-15 Sept.) of the workshop.
- Internet: Strong internet connectivity is required.

This virtual workshop will be realized through co-funding by eCentre and JaNISS as well as contribution by participants based on the fee table below.
